#### Method:

The City of Aurora Voter Poll – July 2023 results are based on a random sample of 400 likely November 2023 voters in the City of Aurora. The worst-case margin of error at the 95% level for the 400 respondents is plus or minus 4.9%. The poll was conducted from July 16-18, 2023, by Keating Research.
